



### **MICHELLE PETRI, MD, MPH**

Michelle Petri, MD, MPH, is Professor of Medicine in the Division of Rheumatology at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. She also serves as Director of the Lupus Center at Johns Hopkins.

Dr Petri earned her medical degree at Harvard Medical School in Boston and completed her internship and residency at Massachusetts General Hospital. She completed her fellowships in allergy, immunology, and rheumatology at the University of California at San Francisco. Her master's in public health and epidemiology were earned at Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health.

In addition to her academic and medical appointments, Dr Petri has authored over 300 papers and chapters on lupus and antiphospholipid antibody syndrome and authored numerous book chapters on systemic lupus erythematosus. She serves on the editorial board of the *Journal of Rheumatology* and *Journal of Clinical Rheumatology*.

She is an active investigator in the Systemic Lupus International Cooperating Clinics and has established a large cohort of patients in the Hopkins Lupus Center to study pregnancy and risk factors for vascular disease in lupus.
